
ORDER

Pending before the court is Plaintiff GPM Industrial, Inc.'s Request for Entry of Default (Docket Entry No. 95). The request establishes that defendants, Petróleos de Venezuela, S.A. and Bariven, S.A., have failed to plead or defend this action. Accordingly, Plaintiff GPM Industrial, Inc.'s Request for Entry of Default (Docket Entry No. 95) is **GRANTED**; and it is **ORDERED** that default is entered against defendants, Petróleos de Venezuela, S.A. and Bariven, S.A., pursuant to Rule 55(a) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. It is also **ORDERED** that, within 20 days from the entry of this Order, plaintiff shall

- (a) move for judgment by default, certifying the notice to the defendants pursuant to Local Rule 5.5 or a suitable alternative method of service;

- (b) submit affidavits with supporting documentation of plaintiff's damages, including a self-explanatory computation of any prejudgment interest sought;
- (c) submit affidavit evidence on attorney's fees, including an explanation of reasonable charges for the necessary service in prosecution of this case; and
- (d) submit a proposed Final Judgment.
